It was heartening to see the enthusiasm of the swimmers at the recent District Development Day in June. We are thankful too to Swimming Victoria and Gary Barclay for facilitating the program. We are also really pleased that the All Junior competition was able to be held. Our younger swimmers did themselves and the wider swimming community proud.

We hope that the district is able to run the Short Course Country Championships in August. There is certainly work going on behind the scenes to help make this happen. 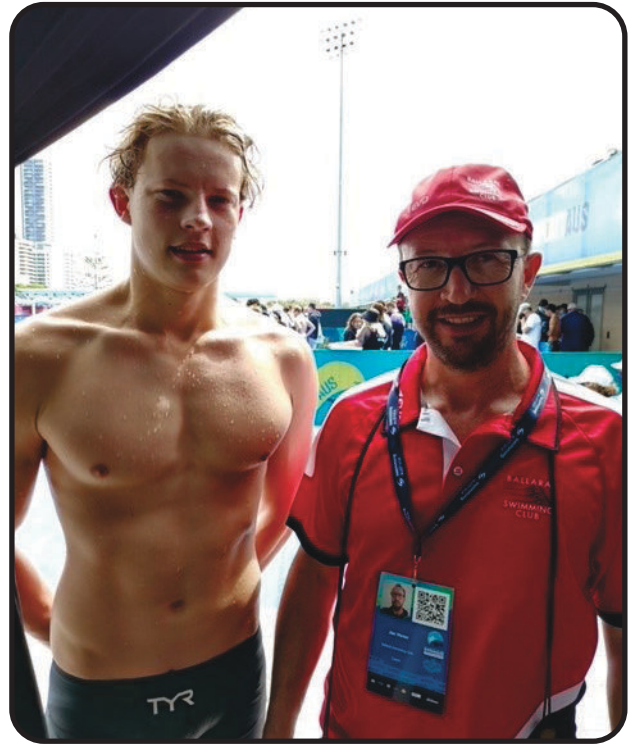

BALLARAT GOLD SWIMMING CLUB

PRESIDENTS REPORT 2020/2021

Our 2020-2021 season continued to throw several curve balls at our swimming community. Each time we have been able to return the pool, our swimmers have done it with great gusto.

Our season started with our swimmers in the water for a short time before returning to lockdown. During this time, we received a wonderful recognition of everyone's hard work for the previous season 2020—our first Swimming Victoria Top10 Club Award- coming in 9th overall. We also had several swimmers recognized in the Swimming Australia Top 25 for their age groups.

Last month, we received further recognition of our swimmers' and coaches dedication and hard work receiving equal 9th place in the 2021 Swimming Victoria Top 10 Club Award.

Further recognition also goes to Jo Peters who received the 2021 Swimming Victoria Volunteer of the Year Award- very well deserved for all her hard work for our District and club.

With our championship events being postponed, including the SC Country Championships to be held in Ballarat, or pushed to later in the season, our first venture as a club was at the LC Country Championships in Warragul.

Despite being out of the pool for several months, and a short preparation time, we saw 49 swimmers head to the Champs-. Our swimmer's shone with their enthusiasm and team spirit gaining PB's, medals and national times with everyone contributing to our 3rd placing overall, exceeding our previous points score.

Our swimmers backed up these events with more qualifying and competing at LC Age, Open and Sprint Championships where further experience, PB's, medals and National times were gained.

March saw many of our up and coming swimmers compete in All Juniors. It was great to see their talent on show for all to see.

In the nick of time, Queensland opened their borders back up to Victorians allowing our biggest team of 21 swimmers to head the Gold Coast to compete at Nationals. This year, we had 11 individual swimmers and a further 10 all competing in our 6 relay teams.

As we returned to lockdown in the second half of the year, with no pool access, developing creative ways to keep fit and motivated became part of our swimmer's lives. Our Coaches took to Zoom, meeting each Sunday afternoon to touch base, check in and set a weekly goal/activity for their training group.

Early December saw us hold a club night at Eureka pool with a training session, some swim offs and relays to build on our team culture followed by a BBQ in and the Eureka Park for our first social gathering since January!

In May, we held our annual Port Fairy Camp, which was a one of our first opportunities to gather for the year and welcome some of our newer members to our Gold family.

We look forward to hosting our SC meet in August in the lead up to co- hosting the 2021 Swimming Victoria SC Country Championships on the 14-15th August.

We are very grateful to the opportunities that the MDASA provide our swimmers, especially to represent their district and the District swimming day offered through Gold Class in June.

We also thank the MDASA who continue to enable their meets be qualifying meets and for providing additional opportunities to support our swimmers and clubs.

We look forward to working together again in 2021-2022.

Behind the scenes our club has utilised the lockdowns to re-examine our club's vision, mission and strategic plan. And our committee has been tirelessly working on moving our club forward and rebuilding our different squads.

Let's hope the next season will not be as restrictive as this season has been.

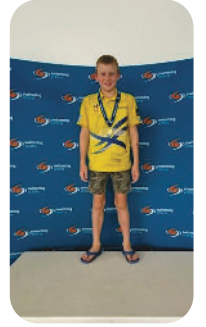
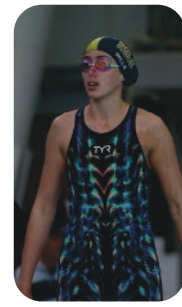
